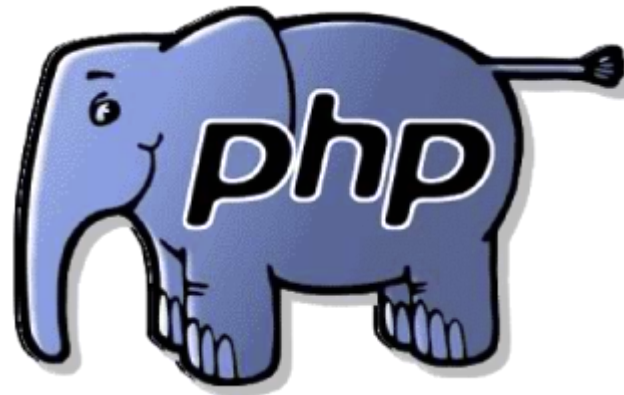

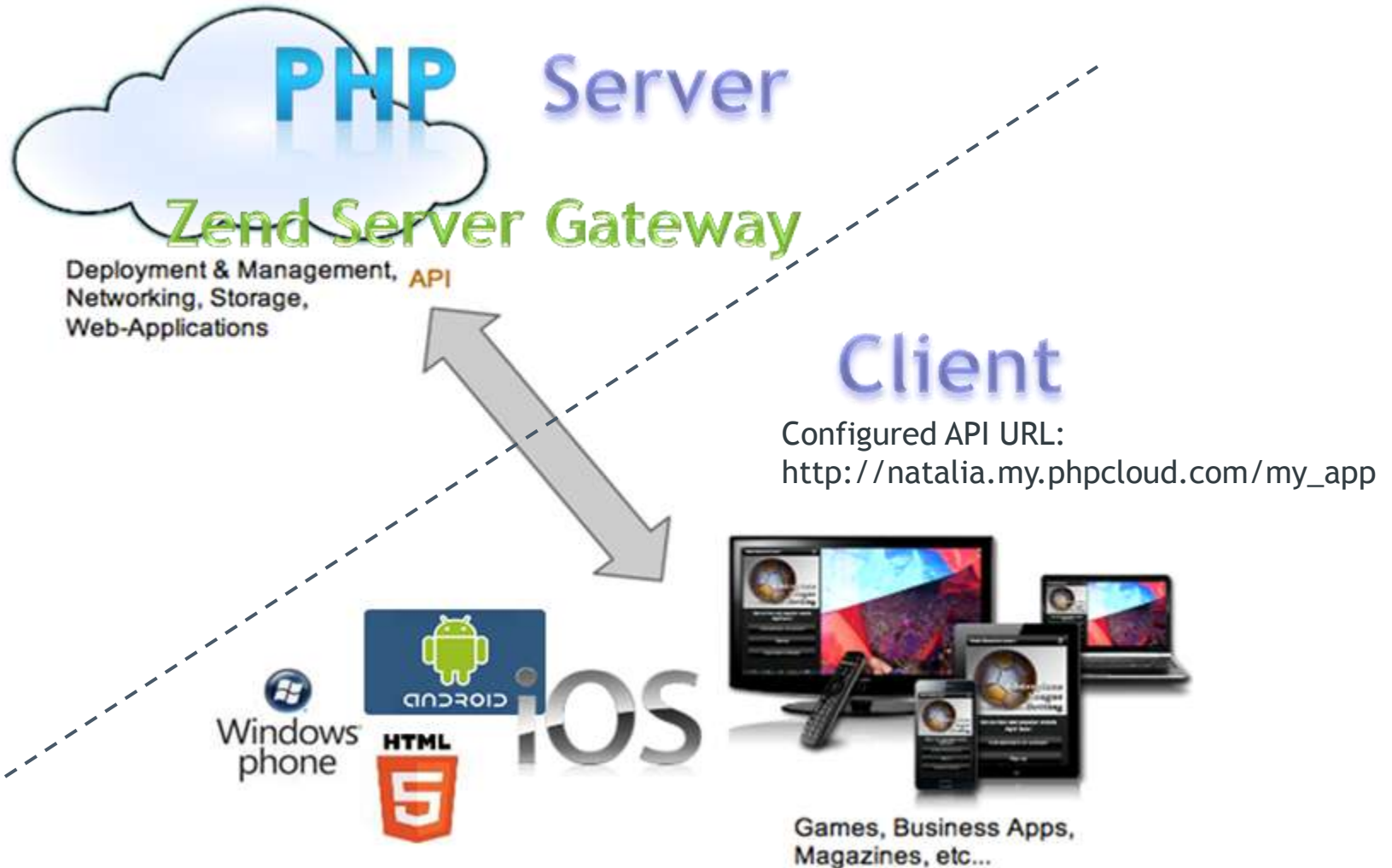

Zend Studio

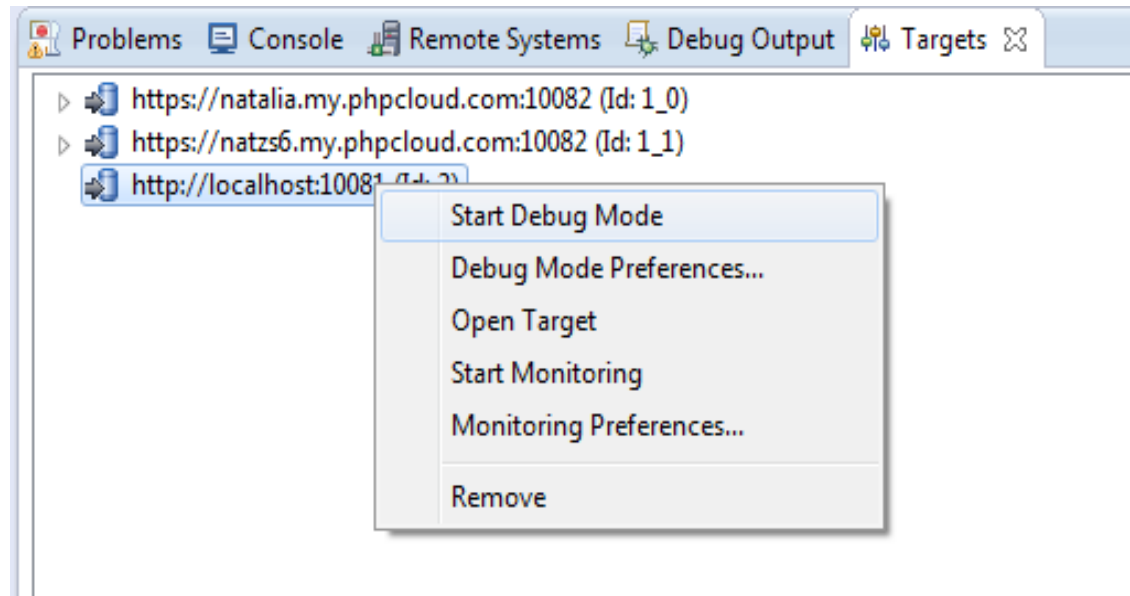
1. Create, manage, test and publish PHP Web Services to the cloud
based on **ZF2/Zend Server Gateway**
2. Create Phonegap Mobile application
 1. Create **Web Mobile** user interface (unified, platform-agnostic)
HTML5 + JavaScript (jQueryMobile)
 2. Bind Web Mobile UI widgets with PHP Web Services
 3. Test Web Mobile project using Web Mobile Emulator
 4. Generate mobile project for specific platform (iOS, Android, Windows Phone)

native environments

3. Build and test (using platform-specific emulators) app-ready mobile package files
 - Android (Zend Studio + ADT)
 - iOS (Zend Studio + xCode)
 - MS phone (Zend Studio + Visual Studio)

Debugging PHP Web Services made easy

- Zend Studio 10 and Zend Server 6 introduce a new ‘Debug Mode’ feature. Once set in Debug Mode, Zend Server 6 will automatically trigger debugger session in Zend Studio on any incoming request, allowing you to set up breakpoints and step over you code. This means debug session can be easily triggered by the request sent from your mobile emulator or real device. You can specify url filters in Debug Mode Preferences to start debug session only for selected services.

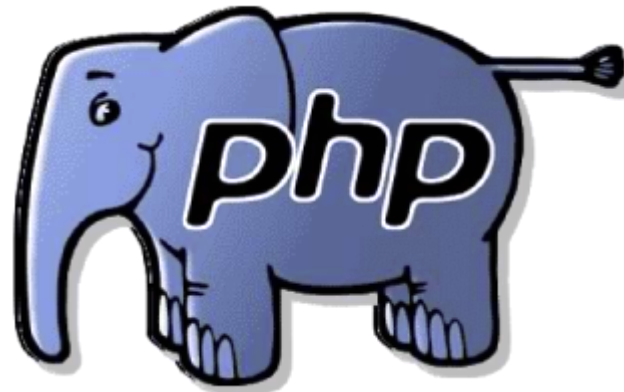
